#### Academic

[Yale] Very competitive. Humanities (English, history, and languages) are focused on group discussions while math and science classes are lecture based (although there are many labs and group activities). Most classes have between 9 and 18 kids. Independent studies are available. Exams and papers are pretty heavily emphasized.
