Academic

[Stanford] Small class size (around 60 per graduating class). Great teachers. College admission officers are very close to the college advisors and even personally come to recruit.

[Stanford] Not focused entirely on exams. Faculty are invested and qualified. Class size is typically less than 15 people. Very large work load.

College Counseling

[Stanford] Statistics show that students applying from Crystal Springs had 2-4 times better chance of getting into the top schools.
